2023-2024 BUDGET

On April 4, 2023 the Village Board adopted a new budget for the 2023-24 fiscal year, effective June 1, 2023. The tax rate will be increased by nine cents per thousand, making the new tax rate \$2.70/thousand. In the new budget, \$153,750 will be used for street maintenance and sidewalk/gutter replacement will be taking place on Raintree Lane. Stamped concrete may also be added on Main Street.

Included in the Village's vehicle replacement plan, \$518,000 has been budgeted for a new street sweeper, 2 pickup trucks, Hybrid SUV, bucket truck and Hydraulic Hammer.

To continue with the street lighting replacement of LED lights, this year we will be installing LED lights on Main Street for \$15,000. Water rates will increase .21 cents from \$3.49 to \$3.70 per 1,000 gallons. The daily consumption rate of .25 cents will increase to .26 cents to match the Monroe County rates. We are seeking a grant to help with a major repair on South Avenue, near Salmon Creek.

The sewer rates will remain unchanged this year. We will continue sewer relining and do improvements to all three of our Lift stations.

DPW NEWS

SUMMER HOURS

Summer hours began the first week in May and are Monday – Thursday 7:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. and Friday 7:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. These hours continue through the end of September.

• APPLIANCE/SCRAP METAL

Pick up is done weekly on Fridays. There is no additional charge for metal pickup unless it contains freon. A fee will then be assessed per item. Examples - air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, etc.

• CONCRETE BOX/DIRT BOX:

The DPW has 2 concrete/dirt boxes for residential rental use. Please call the Village office to reserve one or to be placed on the waiting list if one is not available at that time. These are rented out on a first come/first serve basis with the rental cost being \$10. A resident may keep the box for up to 5 days. If needed longer than the allotted time, an additional \$10 fee will be charged. If the box needs to be emptied and brought back during your rental time frame, an additional \$10 fee will be charged. Once you are done with the box, please call the office for pick up.

DUMPSTERS

Dumpsters are delivered to Village residents/business owners on Fridays and picked up on Wednesdays. from your residence/business.

Dumpster pricing: 6 yd - \$185 9 yd - \$210 10 yd - \$220

- \$70 additional fee for roofing material
- Full cost of dumpster for additional week (no longer than 2 weeks)
- Full cost of dumpster if needing it emptied prior to pick up.

ROAD/SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE:

- The Village of Hilton will be milling/paving Hillside Drive.
- The Village of Hilton will be repairing sidewalks on Raintree Lane starting in May.
- The Village of Hilton will be Slurry Sealing Park Square, Parkwood Lane, Archer Drive, Verney Drive, Panarites Lane, Village II Drive, Salmon Park, Cosman Terrace, Mariah Street, Fraser Drive, Tyler Trail, and Cooper Drive.

DRIVEWAY REPLACEMENT

REMINDER: If you plan on having your driveway replaced, we prefer early notification for scheduling and projects; April is the preferred notification for us to come and inspect for possible sidewalk/gutter replacement. The Village will try and accommodate homeowner paving schedule.

• RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

NEVER PLACE RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES IN THE TRASH OR RECYCLING. Batteries can become crushed and explode when placed in the trash/recycling trucks, causing serious injuries to the workers.

• The Monroe County/Waste Management Ecopark accepts rechargeable batteries from residents only. Call for information (585) 753 - 7600.



TREE LAWN

Your tree lawn is the area between the sidewalk and the road. If you have an item for sale or donation, please do NOT leave it in the tree lawn area. We will collect items left in this location with refuse and you will be billed. It is best to clearly label these items.

REFUSE & STICKERS

REFUSE:

Please have ALL trash out for pick up no later than 7 a.m. on the day of your pickup (please refer to the holiday schedule).

Do NOT put trash out prior to your pickup day.

Carts - You may purchase a 96 gallon trash cart from the Village of Hilton for \$60 or you can use up to 3-32-gallon trash bins of your own. Any trash that exceeds the 96-gallon cart (or the 3-32-gallon trash bins) will require an additional cost. We will bill you for the additional amount of refuse, or you may purchase stickers at the Village Office.

STICKERS:

- Red Stickers Extra bag/container \$2 each
- Green Stickers Bulk items \$6 each
- Light Green Stickers Bulk Refrigerant items \$15 each

METAL/APPLIANCES:

Pick up on Fridays

There is no additional charge for metal pick up unless it has refrigerant/freon in it.

EX: A/C, refrigerator, dehumidifier, freezer, etc. Each item will require a \$15 sticker.

RECYCLING.



There is no limit on recycling and we encourage everyone to recycle. Please have ALL your recycling out by 7 a.m. on your scheduled pickup day.

- Do NOT place items out for pick up prior to your pickup day.
- Cardboard must be broken or cut down to a 2' X 2' square and stacked.
- Do NOT put cardboard or other recycling into an empty cardboard box.



BRUSH/YARD WASTE COLLECTION

BRUSH SCHEDULE:

Pick up is the 1st & 3rd Friday of each month if you live NORTH of West Ave/East Ave.
Pick up is the 2nd & 4th Friday of each month if you live SOUTH of West Ave/East Ave.

- Rake to the tree lawn area. Do NOT place brush into bags, containers or boxes.
- Brush does not have to be cut down into smaller pieces. please keep branches/limbs as long as possible. Place brush in the tree lawn area, with the cut side facing the flow of traffic.
- If extra space is needed, you may place additional brush in your front lawn, keeping the sidewalk clear.

****NOTE - If you have a private contractor cutting or removing a tree(s) at your residence, it is the responsibility of the contractor to haul away all tree debris. The Village will NOT pick up tree debris left from contractors.

YARD WASTE SCHEDULE:

Fri, April 28 Fri, May 26 Fri, June 30 Fri. Septemb<u>er 29</u>

- Acceptable materials Sod, leaves, small stones, gravel, twigs, hedge trimmings, grass, and stumps.
- Do not place in plastic or paper bags. or cardboard boxes.
- Metal or Plastic containers are acceptable.
- Place stumps next to the containers.
- Loose material raked to the curb will not be picked up.
- More than 3 containers is acceptable.
- Place at the curb for collection before 7 a.m.



SOUTH AVENUE WATERMAIN BRIDGE REPAIR

The Village of Hilton discovered a water main leak late summer of 2022 under the Salmon Creek SouthAvenue bridge while performing storm water inspections. There was an emergency repair completed in the fall with the full repair scheduled for late summer/early fall. The cost is approximately \$300,000. The Village has applied for a grant of \$150,000 to help with the costs. The bridge will NOT be shut down during the repair. For more information, please contact the Village Office.

GRANT AWARDED TO VILLAGE



The Village of Hilton was awarded a grant of \$46,800 from NYS Environmental Smart Growth Community Planning and Zoning Program through the Consolidated Funding Application. The Village is planning on using the grant funds to re-write the entire Zoning Code, which is outdated. The Village plans on starting as soon as they receive the final guidance from the State.





MONROE AMBULANCE UPDATE



During the regular Village Board meeting on 11/1/22, a resolution was passed (4-0) to enter into acontract with Monroe Ambulance for EMS services for the year 2023. Monroe Ambulance serves many municipalities in the Rochester area and replaces EMS services which were being provided by CHS. During several meetings and presentations, the Village Board conferred with the Hilton Fire Department and Hilton Parma Fire District regarding this decision. They also received public comments during these meetings.

Calls are categorized as Priority 1, 2, 3 and 4, with priority 1 and 2 calls requesting assistance for events that are serious/life threatening. The Monroe-Livingston EMS standard response times for calls are as follows:

Priority 1: ALS transport on scene 90% of time in 10 minutes

Priority 2: ALS or BLS on scene 90% of time in 12 minutes

Priority 3: ALS or BLS transport on scene 90% to the time in 15 minutes

Priority 4: BLS transport on scene 90% of the time in 25 minutes

During the month of January 2023, Monroe responded to 49 ambulance calls within the Village. They covered 100% of the calls – meaning they did not ask for mutual aid assistance from any other ambulance company.

Priority 1: 5 calls, average response time 6 minutes 48 seconds

Priority 2: 17 calls, average response time 6 minute 16 seconds

Priority 3: 2 calls, average response time 7 minute 35 seconds

Priority 4: 25 calls, average response time 8 minutes 54 seconds

During the month of February 2023, there were 57 calls within the Village with 100% coverage.

Priority 1: 1 call, average response time 1 minute 12 seconds

Priority 2: 25 calls, average response time 5 minutes 51 seconds

Priority 3: 4 calls, average response time 10 minutes 19 seconds

Priority 4: 27 calls, average response time 8 minutes 28 seconds

During the month of March 2023, there were 48 calls within the Village with 100% coverage.

Priority 1: 3 calls, average response time 7 minutes 24 seconds

Priority 2: 18 calls, average response time 8 minutes 8 seconds

Priority 3: 3 calls, average response time 12 minutes 32 seconds

Priority 4: 24 calls, average response time 12 minutes 48 seconds

These response times demonstrate that Monroe Ambulance has met the Monroe-Livingston response time standards for the first quarter of 2023. We would like to thank Monroe for their services.
