

Superintendent's Report

April 2026

Action Items:

- **Resolution:** Wage increase for Bayard Burch
- **Resolution:** To start summer hours on 5/4/2026. Switch to fall schedule on September 25th.

Information Items:

Large flooding event 3/31/26. Obviously, there was a large amount of rain. Detention ponds, sanitary sewer and stormwater overwhelmed. Village II apartments had a few buildings flooded from Salmon Creek rising.

Meeting with the Public on water moving to the Water Authority on 3/10/26 at the Community Center. Around 35-40 residents attended. Monroe County Water Authority was available for questions.

A resident (Ron) at 67 Little Tree Lane is asking for something be done with stormwater leaving the property of 256 East Ave. Chad and I walked the properties. There is some storm pipe installed at 69 Little Tree that the Village of Hilton might have installed in 1970. I can't find any easement on this; it might have been charged to the homeowner if it appears from the files for materials only. He is looking for the Village of Hilton to step in and fix this. Chad and I spoke to James at 256 East Ave to discuss options.

Auction Vac Truck: The auction ended on 3/18/2026. The high bid was 197,000.00. Far short of what I was expecting. I will wait 1 month and put it back on the auction.

Met with Monroe Water authority on 3/19, 3/25 and 3/26. Provided information and mapping.

Met with Ryan from Parma Rec on the 5 K race this Spring. Parma Highway attended. Meeting was 3/18/26 at the community center.

Salt used this season 420 tons - \$30,024.00.

RG&E has finally gotten all our LED streetlighting converted to LED.

PC&G fixed some lights that are out in various locations in the village.

Sold our water meters to the Town of Avon on 3/20/2026. 280 meters. Check received 3/31/2026 \$77,000.00.

John and Jim had a few days repairing refuse truck. PTO replaced.

Kenyon Pipe Relining started video/ documenting sanitary sewers for the grant in the Cedar Terrace area.

Kenyon Pipe previously relined Lake Ave (West side) on 8/2024. A lateral connection was not recut after the relining process. Hard to believe this amount of time passed with no issues. The homeowner had a backup. We spent a day viewing pre-work videos and post work videos and talking with Kenyon Pipe. Kenyon came out to reestablish the missed connection on 3/26/2026. Arrived at 6 pm. They could not find the lateral. I called Brockport DPW at 8 pm, Brockport DPW brought a smaller camera to the location at 9 pm. Traced the lateral and pinpointed the location. Kenyon made the reconnection. Cleaned up and packed up the trucks at 10:20pm. Kenyon Pipe will reline some holes made while we attempted to find the lateral. (No charge)
